

Amount of Total sales by Body Type




- **SUV** tops the Body type in terms of Sales across the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and early 2022 followed by **Sedan** and **Pickup**.
- **SUV** sales stood 11.74M in 2019, 11.68M in 2020 and 13.47M in 2021 respectively followed by **Sedan** sales which were 8.18M in 2019, 7.29M in 2020, 7.27M in 2021 and **Pickup** sales which are 5.11M in 2019, 5.30M in 2020 and 5.295M in 2021.
- SUV sales picked up considerably in 2021 compared to other body types and dominated the market in 2021.

Amount of Used car sales by Body Type




- **SUV** tops the Body type in terms of Used car Sales across the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and early 2022 followed by **Sedan and Pickup.**

Amount of New car sales by Body Type




- **SUV** tops the Body type in terms of Used car Sales across the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and early 2022 followed by **Pickup** and **Sedan.**
- SUV sales stood 5.81M in 2019, 5.62M in 2020 and 6.65M in 2021 respectively followed by Pickup sales which were 2.45M in 2019, 2.465M in 2020, 2.283M in 2021 and Pickup sales which are 2.67M in 2019, 2.12M in 2020 and 2.05M in 2021.
- **SUV** sales picked up considerably in 2021 compared to other body types and dominated the market in 2021. However, in new car segment compared to used or overall, Pickup sales came second compared to Sedan for overall sales across 3 years 3 months.

Total Car Sales by Make (2019 Jan - 2022 Mar)





Total Used Car Sales by Make (2019 Jan - 2022 Mar)





Total New Car Sales by Make (2019 Jan - 2022 Mar)





Yearly Sales by Make





Yearly New Car Sales by Make





























































Monthly Price and MSRP Trend




- For overall car sales, the price and msrp trend dropped during the first quarter of 2020 and there was a

Monthly Price and MSRP Trend for New Cars




- For overall NEW car sales, the price and msrp trend dropped during the first quarter of 2020 and there

Price and MSRP trend for High priced New cars (100k to 5M) vs Other cars (<100k)




Price and MSRP trend of all New cars vs Price, MSRP Trend for Toyota New Cars















- The maximum peak of sales happened in March 2021 post which the sales have again dropped in 2021 overall.


